### Robo Hurdle Race - 16 October 2025

Group C: Grades VI to VIII
Group D: Grades IX to XII

- Each school will register one team.
- · Participating team will consist of 2 members.
- Participants must carry all required equipment and ensure that bots are fully charged before the event. No extra time will be given for charging during or before the race.
- Only students are allowed to operate the bots; teachers are strictly prohibited from handling the bots.
- The bot size must be of 20 cm in width, 25 cm in length, and 15 cm in height. Bots must have a custom-built chassis. Ready-made robots are not allowed.
- Each bot must be equipped with a grabber, which will be required to complete Stage 3.
- There will be 10 stages. Each stage carries 5 points. Points will be awarded upon crossing each stage.
- Each bot needs to follow and complete the path.
- In the event of a tie, the winner will be determined by the least time taken to complete the race.
- Winners will be decided on the basis of design, stages passed and time consumed to complete the race.

- Topic for the debate 'In the Present Global Scenario, UN has Become an Irrelevant Organization'.
- The speakers are required to come in their respective school uniforms.
- The speakers will address the chair only.
- · Participants should refrain from reading a previously prepared script, paper or any aid.
- Unparliamentary language should not be used. No personal comments should be made against any religion, caste, community, political party, or individual. The matter should be limited to the topic only.
- Each speaker shall be given a total of 3 minutes to express their views. The warning bell will ring at the end of 2 minutes, and a final bell will ring at the completion of 3 minutes.
- The participant exceeding the time limit will be liable for negative marking.
- Facts presented in a debate must be accurate.
- The candidate who opted to be the first to speak through a draw will get a minute's time at the end for rebuttal.
- Once the debate starts, the participants are not allowed to discuss with their teachers or anyone else till the programme ends.
- Points awarded by individual judges will be added for each speaker, and then for each team.
- Best Speaker Based on individual performance.
- **Best School Trophy** School with the highest combined team score.
- Queries can be placed for the candidates at the discretion of the judges.
- Reporting time for all the participants will be 8:30 a.m.
- · Judgement will be made on content, fluency, body language and confidence.

## Robo Dangal - 17 October 2025

This competition is for Group C & D.

### Group C: Grade VI to VIII Group D: Grade IX to XII

- Each school will register only one team per group.
- Team will consist of 2 members.
- Participants must carry their own robot. Only 1 robot is allowed from each school.
- Teachers are not allowed to operate the robot.
- Each robot should not weigh more than 5 kilograms.
- The bot should not be larger than 20 cm in width, and 25 cm in length, 15 cm in height.
- Robots with sharp edges, weapons that can harm humans or other robots will be disqualified.
- The bot can be autonomous, remote-controlled, wired, or wireless.
- Operating voltage of the bot cannot be more than 15V DC.
- Ready-made robots are strictly prohibited.

- There will be three rounds. Each round will be of 3 minutes.
- The match will be a one-on-one competition between two robots.
- The winner of the match will be the robot that pushes the opponent out of the ring or disables it within the time limit.
- If both the robots fall out of the ring at the same time, the match will be declared a draw and replayed.
- If neither of the robots is able to push the other out of the ring or disable it, the winner will be decided by the judges based on factors such as aggression, control and style.
- If a robot falls out of the ring, is unable to move or is disabled, it loses the match.
- Participants should take care of their robots; the host school is not responsible for any damage caused.

# Volleyball - 17 October 2025

This competition is for Group D.

#### Group D: Grades IX to XII

- A team must consist of 12 members and a coach.
- The tournament is open to Under-18 Girls.
- Game Format:
- Matches will be played in a knockout format.
- Each side is allowed a maximum of 3 hits to return the ball.
- A player cannot hit the ball twice in a row (except when blocking; a block is not considered a hit).
- Rally point scoring will be used a point is scored on every serve, regardless of which team served.
- Ball Play Rules:
- The ball may be played off the net during a volley or serve.
- A ball that hits the boundary line is considered in.
  A ball is considered out if it:
- - -hits the antennae, net post, referee stand, or pole
  - -falls completely outside the court
  - -touches any part of the net or cables outside the antennae
  - -enters a non-playable area

#### Legal & Illegal Moves:

- Players can contact the ball with any part of the body while receiving the serve.
- It is illegal to catch, hold, or throw the ball.
- Players are not allowed to spike or block the serve.
- Points are made on every serve for the winning team of a rally (rally-points scoring).
- A player cannot hit the ball twice in succession. (A block is not considered a hit)
- In case of dues (delays), the opponent team will be awarded 2 consecutive points.
- All players must carry a valid school identity card.
- Teams must report at 8:30 a.m.
- Any disputes will be settled by the officials, and their decision will be final and binding.

• The organizing school will not be held responsible for any incidents caused due to indiscipline or misconduct.
